

**TERMS AND REGULATIONS  
FOR NEW PARTICIPANTS UNDER THE  
MALAYSIA MY SECOND HOME (MM2H) PROGRAMME  
MINISTRY OF TOURISM, ARTS AND CULTURE  
MALAYSIA**

---

**GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

- (i) Participation into the MM2H Programme is open to every eligible foreign individual from sovereign countries with diplomatic relations with Malaysia;
- (ii) 25 years and above for all categories;
- (iii) Application should be submitted and completed through an MM2H tour operating businesses that has been licensed by the Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture under the Tourism Industry Act 1992 [*Act 482*]; and
- (iv) Every application from participants, new or renewal, needs to be conducted through the One Stop Centre, Malaysia My Second Home (OSC MM2H). All matters concerning immigration including the final approval are under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Home Affairs through the Immigration Department. Any appeals, if any, is the under the purview of the Minister of Home Affairs.

## TERMS AND REGULATIONS UNDER EACH CATEGORY

### A. Platinum Category

<b>PARTICIPATING FEE (ONE-OFF)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. A participating fee of <b>RM200,000 for every principal application</b> (one-off).</li> <li>ii. <b>No participating fees for dependents.</b></li> </ul>
<b>PURCHASE OF RESIDENCE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. <b>Compulsory</b> to purchase and own a residence after obtaining the approval as MM2H participant.</li> <li>ii. <b>Value of the purchased residence</b> should be <b>RM 2 million or above.</b></li> <li>iii. <b>Selling of the residence is not allowed for 10 years.</b> However, the house can be upgraded (buying of a new residence) to a residence of higher value from the current property.</li> </ul>

<b>EDUCATION</b>	Dependent/s (children) is <b>allowed</b> to pursue their education up to tertiary level in any Government-recognised higher learning institutions in Malaysia. Dependent/s (children) is allowed to use the existing MM2H or be given a Student Pass automatically.
<b>MEDICAL</b>	Long term medical treatment is <b>allowed</b> in Malaysia.
<b>BUSINESS/ INVESTMENT ACTIVITIES</b>	<b>Permissible.</b>
<b>CAREER OPPORTUNITIES</b>	<b>Permissible.</b>
<b>MEDICAL CHECK-UP</b>	<b>Compulsory</b> to undergo medical check-up in panel clinic/ hospital appointed by the Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture for the principal and their dependents after receiving the approval to participate in the MM2H Programme. Check-ups in appointed clinics/ hospital are necessary to ensure the services and charges are standardise for all applicants.
<b>CATEGORY SPECIALITY</b>	<b>Tax exemption</b> on incoming funds such as FD.

<p><b>CHANGE OF PRINCIPAL</b></p>	<p>In the event of death of the principal, the MM2H Pass of the deceased is <b>transferable to the next-of-kin</b> among the registered dependents.</p>

**B. Gold Category**

All requirements for offshore income for every category are dropped.</li> <li>iii. Maximum <b>withdrawal of 50% is allowed on the principal FD value after the approval as MM2H participant has been obtained for the purposes of purchasing a residence, education, medical and tourism activities in Malaysia.</b></li> </ul>
<b>PARTICIPATING FEE (ONE-OFF)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. A participating fee of <b>RM3,000 for every principal application (one-off).</b></li> <li>ii. <b>No</b> participating fees for dependents.</li> </ul>
<b>PURCHASE OF RESIDENCE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. <b>Compulsory</b> to purchase and own a residence after obtaining the approval as MM2H participant.</li> <li>ii. <b>Value of the purchased residence</b> should be <b>RM 1 million or above.</b></li> <li>iii. <b>Selling of the residence is not allowed for 10 years.</b> However, the house can be upgraded (buying of a new residence) to a residence of higher value from the current property.</li> </ul>

<p><b>MM2H PASS</b></p>	<p>i. MM2H pass for a period of 15 years with Multiple Entry Visa (MEV)</p> <p>ii. Renewable</p> <p>iii. Validity of the hologram security sticker in the passport will depend on the approved length of the MM2H pass, based on the passport validity of the participant.</p> <p>iv. If the validity of the participant's passport expires before the end of the MM2H pass, the participant is required to renew the</p>

	security sticker to be included in the new passport.
<b>EDUCATION</b>	Dependent/s (children) is <b>allowed</b> to pursue their education up to tertiary level in any Government-recognised higher learning institutions in Malaysia. Dependent/s (children) is allowed to use the existing MM2H or be given a Student Pass automatically.
<b>MEDICAL</b>	Long term medical treatment is <b>allowed</b> in Malaysia.

**C. Silver Category**

All requirements for offshore income for every category are dropped.</li> <li>iii. Maximum <b>withdrawal of 50% is allowed on the principal FD value after the approval as MM2H participant has been obtained</b> for the purposes of <b>purchasing a residence, education, medical and tourism activities in Malaysia.</b></li> </ul>
<b>PARTICIPATING FEE (ONE-OFF)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. A participating fee of <b>RM1,000 for every principal application (one-off).</b></li> <li>ii. <b>No</b> participating fees for dependents.</li> </ul>
<b>PURCHASE OF RESIDENCE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. <b>Compulsory</b> to purchase and own a residence after obtaining the approval as MM2H participant.</li> <li>ii. <b>Value of the purchased residence</b> should be <b>RM600,000 or above.</b></li> <li>iii. <b>Selling of the residence is not allowed for 10 years.</b> However, the house can be upgraded (buying of a new residence) to a residence of higher value from the current property.</li> </ul>

	iv. Failure to comply to any of the terms will result in the <b>MM2H pass to be revoked.</b>

<b>DEPENDENTS</b>	<p>Participant is <b>allowed</b> to bring dependents as follows:</p> <p>i. spouse (wife/ husband);</p> <p>ii. biological children/ stepchildren/ adopted children below the age of 21 while those between the age of 21 to 34, must be unemployed and single while in Malaysia;</p> <p>iii. medically certified children with disabilities (no age limit); and</p> <p>iv. parents and/ or parents in law.</p>
<b>MM2H PASS</b>	<p>i. MM2H pass for a period of 5 years with Multiple Entry Visa (MEV)</p> <p>ii. Renewable</p> <p>iii. Validity of the hologram security sticker in the passport will depend on the approved length of the MM2H pass, based on the passport validity of the participant.</p>

	iv. If the validity of the participant's passport expires before the end of the MM2H pass, the participant is required to renew the security sticker to be included in the new passport.
<b>EDUCATION</b>	Dependent/s (children) is <b>allowed</b> to pursue their education up to tertiary level in any Government-recognised higher learning institutions in Malaysia. Dependent/s (children) is allowed to use the existing MM2H or be given a Student Pass automatically.
